Background



Cyril Ramaphosa Foundation partnered with Siziwe Ngcwabe Foundation to offer educational support to orphaned and vulnerable learners to help them stay in school. The project was selected based on its alignment with one of the Foundation's pillars which is education. The partnership between the Foundation and Siziwe Ngcwabe Foundation will run for a duration of a year (2022). Siziwe Ngcwabe Foundation is an NPC that exists to empower orphaned and vulnerable children to reach their potential. The Foundation works with NGOs that care and support orphaned and vulnerable children in communities. In Nellmapius the Siziwe Ngcwabe Foundation works with an NGO called Siyadinga Childcare Forum. In Atteridgeville the Foundation works with Unpredictable Football Club which uses football to effect social change in learners. Siziwe Ngcwabe Foundation goes out to seek funding to assist learners in the two townships.



Phase 2 Distribution

Phase 2 of the project was the distribution of winter uniform in May 2022. The winter uniform was distributed on 23 May 2022 in Nellmapius and 27 May 2022 in Atteridgeville. The items distributed during phase two of the project included:

- two long sleeve shirts/gold t-shirts
- one long pants/shirt/tunic
- two pairs of long socks
- one jersey/drymac
- one beanie
- one scarf



The last phase will be the celebratory event at the end of the year for the learners of Nellmapius and Atteridgeville which will include fun and educational activities. The learners from both communities were grateful for the donations and the new school uniform that will help them get through the cold winter.
